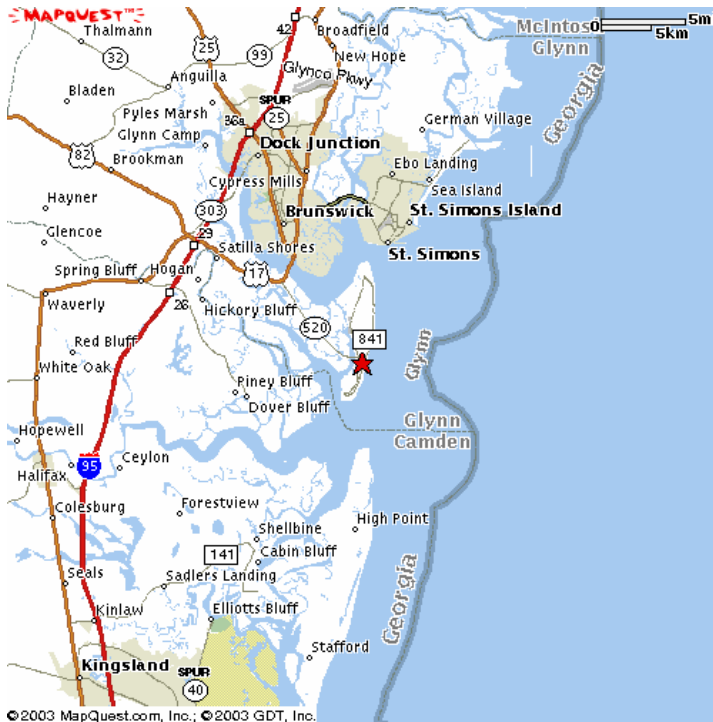


2008 Maps and Directions

Jekyll Island is located just off the Georgia coast, midway between Savannah, Georgia and Jacksonville, Florida. A six-mile causeway separates Jekyll from the mainland and the City of Brunswick. One of many barrier islands on Georgia's coast, Jekyll is neighbored to the north by St. Simons Island and the south by Cumberland Island.



The easiest way to get to Jekyll Island is to get off I-95 at exit 29. Go north on Hwy 17 until you come to the Jekyll Island Causeway (Hwy 520), just before the Sidney Lanier Bridge. Turn East on Hwy 520, pass through the toll booth (\$3 per vehicle, state vehicles exempt), and come to the stop sign at the convention center. Turn right (south) and drive for approximately 2.5 miles and the 4-H Center is on the left (Ocean Side).
