RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach interdisciplinary marine & science-based environmental education classes, conduct evening programs, provide leadership to school groups participating in the program, and maintain teaching laboratories.



REQUIREMENTS: Commitment, genuine interest in children, dynamic personality, well-developed communication skills, creativity, and leadership ability. A Bachelor or Associate degree in Education, Natural Science, Environmental Education, or a related field preferred. Additional training in environmental education is provided. All successful applicants must consent to a background check.

SEASON: 9 ½ months, mid-August – late May, staff training provided.

SALARY: \$8.45/hr (works out to \$338 for a 40-hour work week which is typical). Anything worked over 40 hours per week is paid as overtime. On-site housing is available for a small fee. Small insurance policy is provided for successful applicants.
