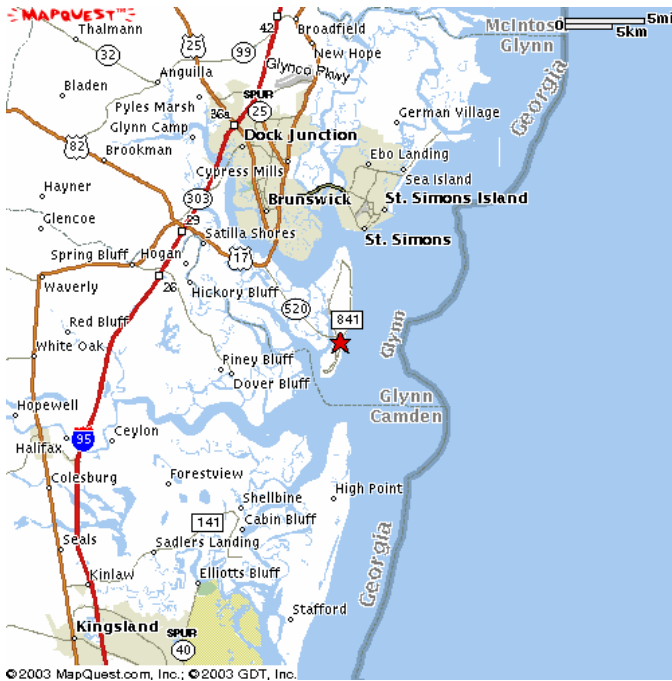


# Maps and Directions

Jekyll Island is located just off the Georgia coast, midway between Savannah, Georgia and Jacksonville, Florida. A six-mile causeway separates Jekyll from the mainland and the City of Brunswick. One of many barrier islands on Georgia's coast, Jekyll is neighbored to the north by St. Simons Island and the south by Cumberland Island.



The easiest way to get to Jekyll Island is to get off I-95 at exit 29. Go north on Hwy 17 until you come to the Jekyll Island Causeway (Hwy 520), just before the Sidney Lanier Bridge. Turn East on Hwy 520, pass through the toll booth (\$5. per vehicle, state vehicles exempt), The island has lots of construction going on so please take the first right on Riverview and go all the way around until you see the 4-H Center on the right.
