

## What to Bring to Jekyll 4-H Camp

**\*\*\*\*Everything should be marked in the child's name with a waterproof marker. Do not bring jewelry, cell phones, electronics, or other items of value\*\*\*\***

### Items to Bring:

- Waterproof sunscreen
- Linens, blankets or sleeping bag, pillow (Linens are NOT provided at camp)
- Daily change of clothes and underwear (shorts, tee shirts, etc. Pack clothes that can get dirty and sandy!)
- Shoes and Socks (Bring at least 2 pairs—one that can get wet and muddy) and/or sports sandals with a heel strap – NO FLIP-FLOPS ALLOWED AT CAMP!
- Towels (wash cloth, shower towels and beach/pool towels)
- Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush and other toiletries
- One piece bathing suits (t-shirts required over 2 piece suits or if deemed inappropriate)
- Rain jacket
- Sunglasses and/or hat
- Money for canteen
- Plastic garbage bag for wet clothes
- Insect Repellent
- Money for lunch for bus trip to and from camp as needed. Please contact your county office for this information.
- Day Pack
- Water Bottle
- Camera, film (use of disposables is recommended, mark your full name on camera)
- Shower Shoes
- Pen, paper, stamps

### DO NOT BRING:

- Knives
- Radios, video games, CD players, or Cell phones (NO CELL PHONES AT ALLOWED AT CAMP!)
- Shaving cream
- Fireworks
- Chewing gum
- Excessive amount of cash or items of great value (emotional or monetary)

### Clothing guidelines:

1. No clothing should be worn that violates the Code of Conduct.
2. Underwear should be worn at all times and should not be visible.
3. Camp is rough on clothes—bring only clothes that are okay to get wet or muddy.
4. Bring extra socks and underwear—you always need them!
